Membership Application – Non-Profit Sector

The Great Lakes Partnership welcomes the involvement of non-profit sector organizations in the work of the partnership as Class B members. Class B members pay dues relative to the size of their revenues: 501(c) non-profit organizations with revenues greater than \$10 million pay annual membership dues of \$1,000. 501(c) non-profit organizations with revenues less then \$10 million pay annual membership dues of \$500. Representatives of Class B members are eligible to serve on GLP task forces, may be elected to serve on the board of directors and steering committee. Class B membership is in the name of an organization that is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986.

Founding Membership is offered to companies, organizations and institutions that elect to take leadership roles in the Partnership and make an initial contribution (inclusive of first-year dues) of \$10,000.
